The Bourbon County Commission met in open session with all commissioners and the county clerk present. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Marty Pearson gave a road report.

The Pioneer Harvest Fiesta committee is asking for a culvert replacement at the northeast entrance to the Bourbon County Fairgrounds. The work needs to wait until next week, because the County Fair is going this week.

There was a meeting with Sewer District entities at 10:00 am. Stuart Porter and Mark Houser, Schwab-Eaton, Geri & Rick McInroy, McInroy Contractors, Terri Johnson, County Attorney and Tom McNeil, County Sanitarian, were present. All parties updated on their status. Stuart also recommended that commissioners approve Pay Estimate #4, in the amount of \$114,777.27. Chairman Endicott signed the Pay Estimate. McInroy is concerned with the timeframes listed on the letter sent in early July. Those times were meant for the homeowners to be pro-active, not to be held by the contractors, as they may be impossible in some cases.

Jim Harris, Berry Tractor and Charlie Morse, Neosho County Road & Bridge Supervisor, met with commissioners to discuss rock crushing equipment. Mr. Morse explained the set-up in Neosho County. No action at this time.

Doylene Chapman presented the Kansas Retailer's Sales Tax quarterly report for Road & Bridge. The chairman signed it.

Commissioners worked on the 2012 budget for the rest of the meeting with Terry Sercer.



After routine business, the meeting adjourned at 2:30 pm.
