Marty reported that there is a bridge at 35th & Soldier road that the county is putting some shot rock underneath. He also said they are working on Jayhawk road this week.

Marty talked about a bridge east of the landfill on Noble road that will need some maintenance. When the work is done the funding will be provided by T-works.

Tom Peery stopped by the commission meeting to talk about the work that was being done in the Gunn Park addition. He also thanked the county for the work that is being done there.

Robert Query came to the commission meeting to visit with the commissioners.

Terri Coop talked to the commissioners about a call she had from KDHE, someone is burning the debris from the old Iga grocery store. She is going to go to the burning site with the rural fire department to evaluate the situation.

The commissioners adjourned at 12:02.
