The Bourbon County Commission met in open session with all commissioners and the deputy county clerk present.

Allen Warren said Dave Martin spoke with him about a building at the golf course that is being torn down, Dave Martin wanted to know if the City of Fort Scott could dispose of the C&D from this building at the Bourbon County Landfill, and have the fees waived, all commissioners agreed to allow this.

Harold Coleman said he had talked to Brian Snyder, Brian inquired about a bridge west of 215th & Yellowstone that needs to be repaired.

Jim Harris with Berry Tractor came by the meeting.

Marty Pearson will send in for an extension at the Blake quarry.

At 10:00 am, the commissioners opened the bids for the track hoe, they are as follows...

Victor Phillips - 2009 Hyundai crawler excavator, model B210-LCD, with 1350 hours on it, delivery will be as soon as the hydraulic thumb is delivered = \$114,500.

Custom Truck & Equipment - 2011 Doosan, model DX225LC with 885 hours on it = \$148,000.

Murphy Tractor - 2008 John Deere model 200D, with 2900 hours on it, with a 5000 hour warranty = \$154,453.

Foley Equipment - 2011 CAT 320DL, with 1340 hours on it = \$169,500.

Berry Tractor - 2008 Komatsu model PC200LC-8, with 2125 hours, delivered price = \$145,607.

All of the track hoe bids had the similar Horse power and weight.

Terri Johnson and Dan Meara discussed the upcoming tax sale, Dan Meara is trying to balance between doing work for the tax sale and his private practice. Dan Meara will speak with Debbi Engstrom about the tax sale. Originally Bourbon County entered into a contract for the tax sale on October 5th, 2012, however that contract needs to be voided and they need to enter into a new contract on November 5th, 2012. Harold Coleman made the motion and Jingles Endicott seconded & all voted in favor.

Jingles Endicott spoke with Terri Johnson about Drywood Township. Jingles Endicott said he was told by trustees that the Fire District has hired an attorney & was paying the fees for this out of their budget, Jingles Endicott was inquiring about the rights and laws of this. Terri Johnson explained that Drywood Township has also hired an attorney & explained that they should follow advice from their counsel. Terri Johnson advises the commissioners not to step in the middle of the townships day to day business.

Valorie Leblanc came to the commission meeting to discuss the account for the sewer district.

The meeting adjourned at 11:45 am.
